



ETTIQUETTE TO BE OSERVED WHILE VISITING DARWIN GURUDWARA SAHIB

- **Sikhs kneel and bow in front of the Guru Granth Sahib** upon joining the congregation.
- **Non-Sikhs** may choose **not to** kneel and/or bow but should enter and quietly join the congregation.
- Most attendees will sit on the floor during the congregation and langar (vegetarian food served), **with the exception of those with any medical or physical impairment**. Benches are available for them to use.
- **Stand up during Ardaas** (supplication prayer to God).
- **Sit on the floor during langar** and keep head cover at all times.
- **No alcohol, tobacco, or smoking** on the gurudwara premises.
- **Clapping is not allowed** inside the Prayer Hall.
- **For Path program and Payments**, please contact SANTI President or Secretary to discuss about the program and payment options.
- **No posters/information** to be displayed at the SANTI premises without approval from the SANTI Executive Committee.
- **All SANTI announcements** shall be rendered under the direction of the SANTI Executive Committee or by persons authorised by SANTI Executive Committee. Unauthorised individuals are not allowed to make any public announcements without the permission of the SANTI Executive Committee.
