## VISITING DARWIN GURUDWARA SAHIB

**All visitors are required to follow the below Dress Code and Gurudwara Sahib Protocol**

- Please wear appropriate attire, suitable to place of worship. For example:

✓ Appropriate	X Not Appropriate
<b>Women</b> to wear Punjabi suits, dress/blouse or Kurtis which is <u>no shorter than knee length</u> with long pants, leggings, or jeans.	<b>Miniskirts, shorts, skirts, short blouses/short T-shirts worn with jeans, leggings or gym pants are not appropriate attire.</b>
<b>Men</b> to wear Punjabi Kurta pajama suits, Shirts, T-shirts, long pants, jeans, or <u>knee length</u> shorts.	<b>Sleeveless T-shirts, Sports/Gym Shorts, low hanging pants, and tight-fitting pants are not allowed.</b>

- **Always cover your head with headscarf/dupatta** while in the main Gurudwara areas (i.e., Darbar Sahib {prayer Hall} and Langar Hall) as a sign of respect to the Guru Granth Sahib Ji.
- **No caps, hats or hoddies are allowed.**
- **Remove shoes** when entering the congregation hall as a sign of respect to the sovereignty of the Guru Granth Sahib Ji. All visitors entering the main prayer hall (Darbar Sahib), and the dining (Langar) Hall will remove their shoes and place them in the shoe racks.

**Gurudwara Sahib is a place of worship.  
Please observe its sanctity and be respectful at all times.**
